With the pace of events so far this year, we can't help but feel the rush of the Spirit surrounding us, flowing through us, and pushing us on further into where God is sending us – our mission. Mission is a thankful response to God's gifts for us. It begins with prayer, opening ourselves to receive and acknowledge the gifts for ministry, listening for guidance and how to use those gifts, and responding with thanks for the opportunity to reveal the kingdom of God in love and service.

We are grateful for all the gifts of time, talent, and treasure offered by our Parish family and our community partners. As a reflection of that gratitude, the theme for our Stewardship Approach this year is 'Thanksgiving'. During Sunday morning worship on November 26th, we lead discussions to talk about mission, gratitude, opportunities, concerns and needs for you as individuals and as a parish family.

This package is a supplement to those discussions to help further your discernment.
