The Cooperative Care Centre formerly known as the Brockville Warming Centre, is a project of the Brockville Housing Partnership. The Centre is a safe, consistent, and non-judgemental place where folks with no permanent residence, who are suffering from homelessness can stay warm/cool overnight, take a shower, and store their items with us temporarily. Guests receive a warm meal, breakfast, snacks, drinks, and supplies they may need while staying with us.

Hours of Operation: 4PM-8AM

Intake Hours: 4PM-11PM

Maximum Capacity: 15 (first come, first serve basis)

Location: 1805 County Rd. 2, Brockville, ON
